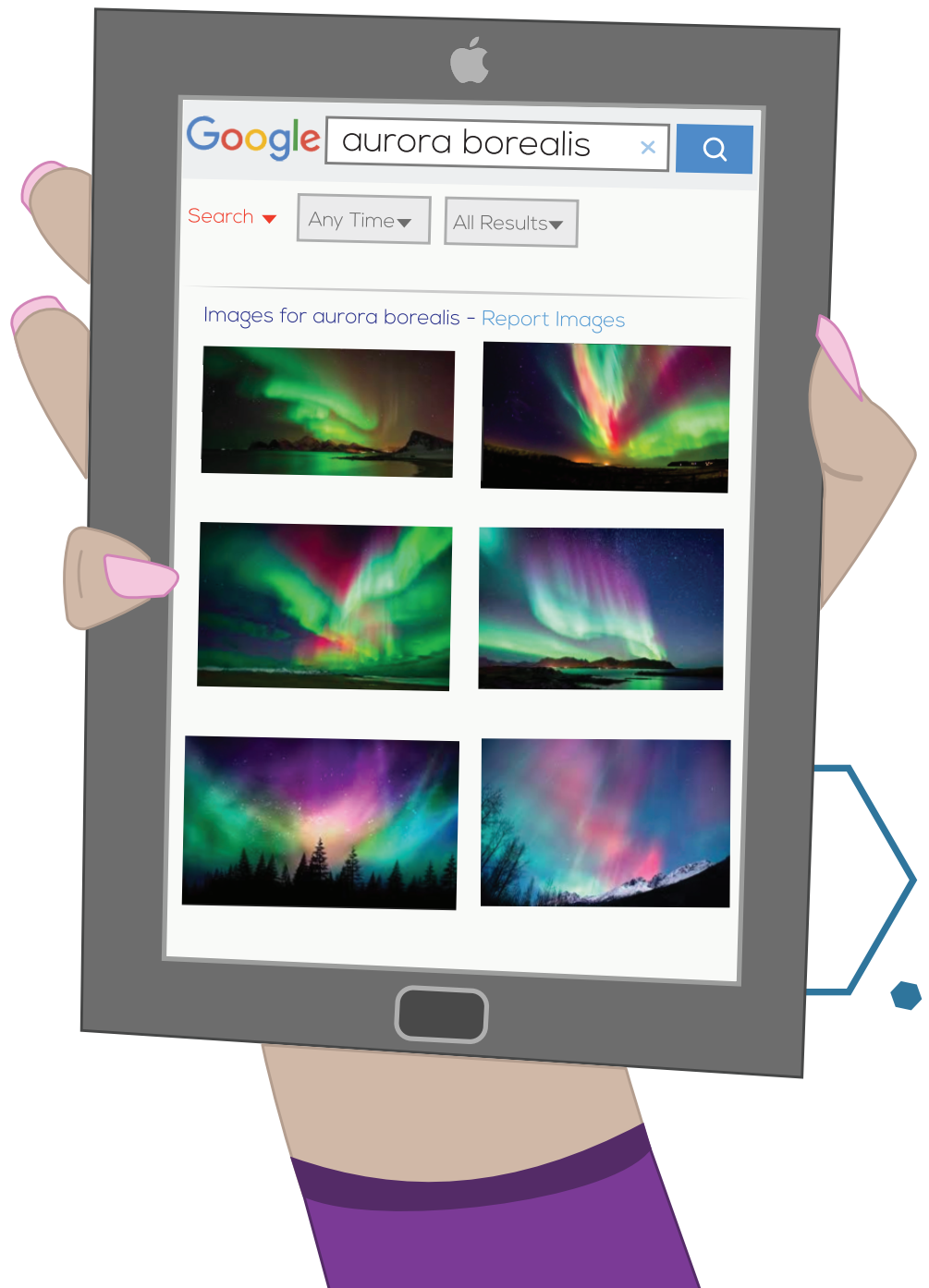

Find the Chrome app

- Find the Chrome app. You can look for it on your device's home screen.
- Tap on the **Chrome** app to open it
- If Chrome isn't installed on your device, open the App Store. You can search for Chrome and download the app. If you've never downloaded apps before, do [this lesson](#).

Search the weather

- You can search for many things on Google. For example, you can search for the weather in any city.
- Type **weather Toronto** in the search bar. Then, tap the search button.

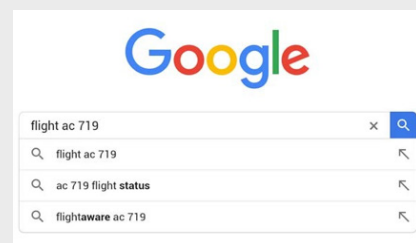

View the search result

- You can drag the slider left and right to see the temperature for different hours of the day
- You can see the weather for other days of the week by tapping on the different days

Search for flight information

- Searching for a flight number will give you information about a flight. You can use this search to find out when a plane is leaving or if it has arrived.
- Click the **X** next to the search button to start a new search
- For practice, search **flight AC 719**. "AC" stands for Air Canada.

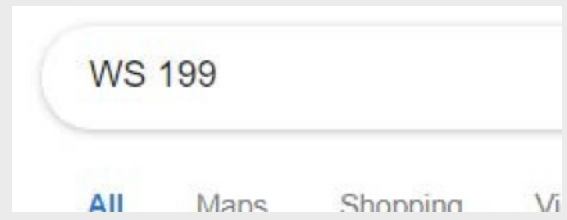

 - If there are any delays
 - What time the flight will land
