



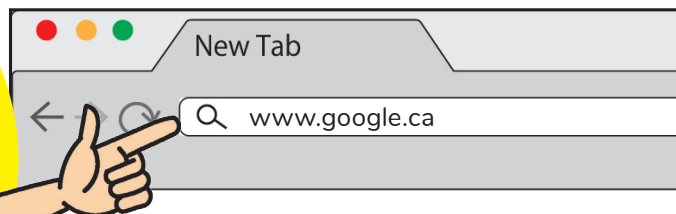
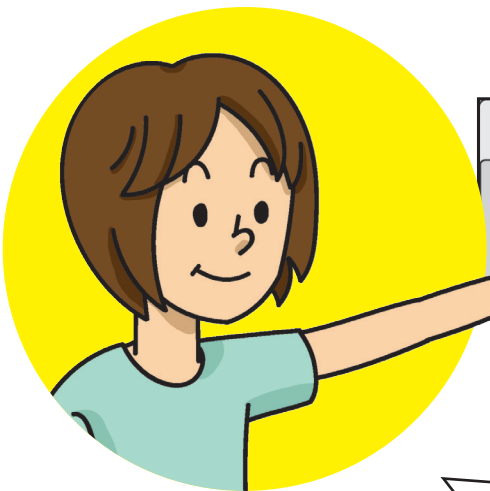

# Let's open Google Chrome



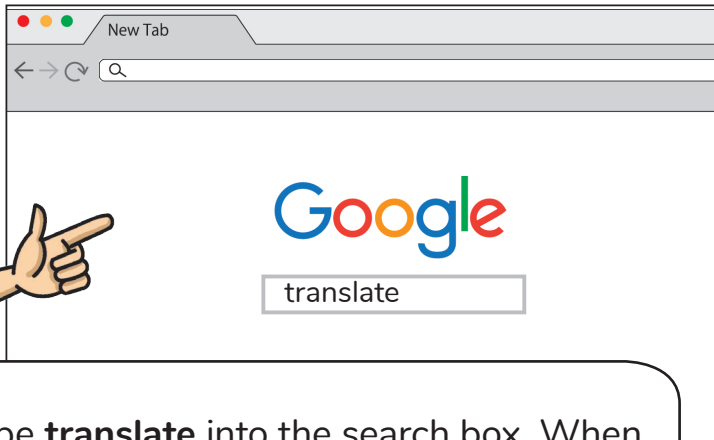
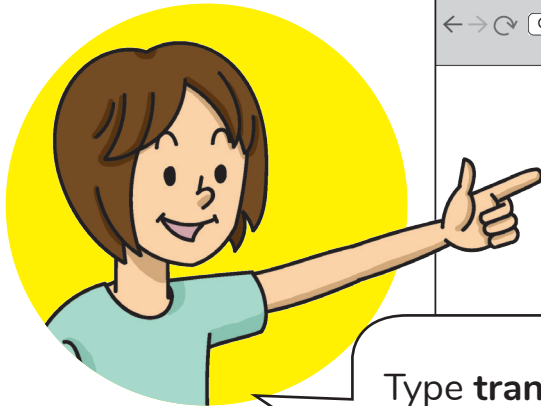
On the bottom of the screen is where we can find Google Chrome. Can you click it once to open it?



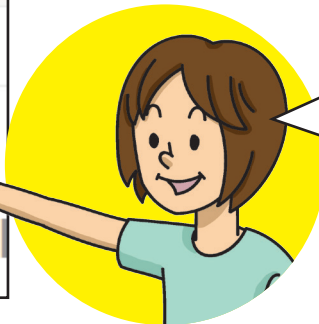
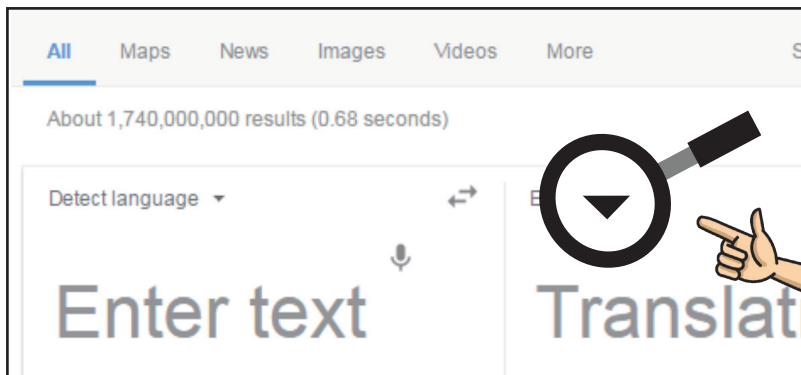
Click over here on the address bar. This is where we can type any website we want to go to. Can you type **www.google.ca**?

When you're done, press

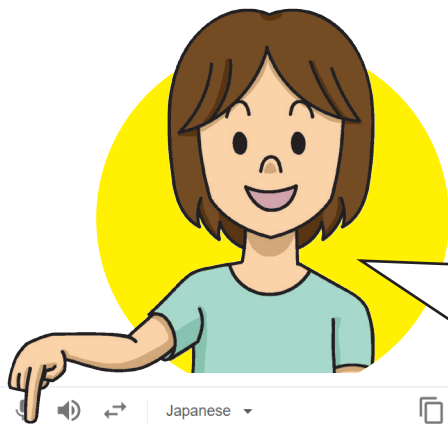
# Let's translate words into other languages



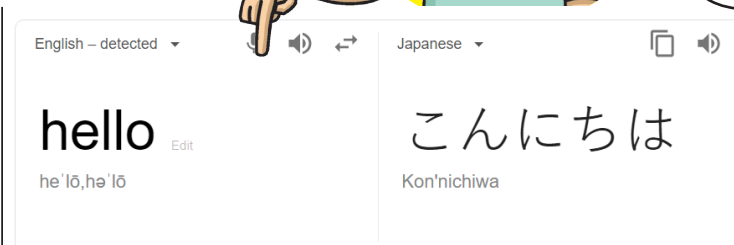
Type **translate** into the search box. When you're done, press **enter**

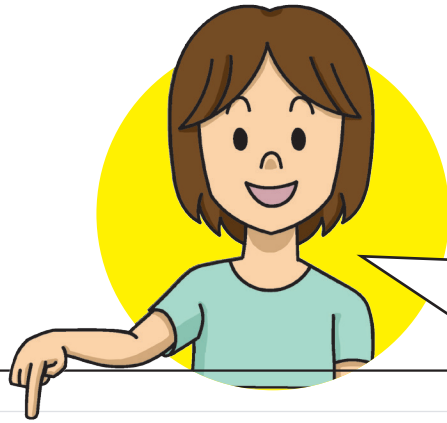


Now click on the arrow next to **English**. Change this to **Japanese**.

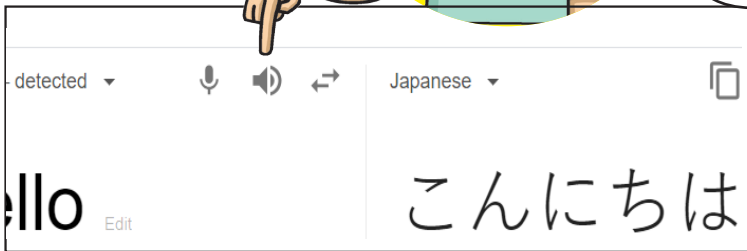


In the first text box, type **hello**. Now you'll see "hello" in Japanese.

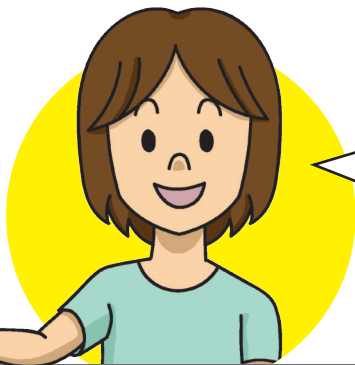
