Dear **ELECTED OFFICIAL**,

As a constituent, **cancer survivor/patient/advocate and Cervivor Advocate**, **I urge you to vote NO on any Medicaid cuts.**

The One Big Beautiful Bill Act recently passed in the U.S. Senate, includes provisions that will limit access to affordable health care by kicking at least 8.6 million people off of Medicaid and other programs that provide affordable health insurance. States would be forced to make up for the federal cuts by increasing taxes or cutting health care services to vulnerable people. This isn't fiscal responsibility; it's simply shifting costs to states, patients, and local hospitals.

One in 3 children with cancer and 1 in 10 adults with a history of cancer rely on Medicaid for their health care.
