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## PROFILES

Founded in 1969, the **DuPage Community Concert Band** started as a daytime concert band for students and a nighttime band for the community. In 1982, the band was consolidated into one community group. The size of the group has grown ever since.

The band plays two concerts per semester in the McAninch Arts Center Belushi Performance Hall. Membership is open to all high school graduates with woodwind, brass or percussion experience who are otherwise qualified to register. Auditions are required for chair placement, but no one is refused membership. Membership is open each semester in all sections. Call (630) 942-2048 for registration information.

Through music education, and the performance of our music literature, we desire to help facilitate the enjoyment of playing in a band program for all who wish to do so. The exposure to the beauty and expression of music, and the involvement in the activities that are congruent to a person's involvement in the fine arts, will forever enhance that person's life.

The DuPage Community Concert Band program exists to embrace and express all of the beauty and glory we can share with each other through playing great music. We try to program concerts that are entertaining to the audiences, stimulating to the performer, and consistent with the representation and growth of the college and community band medium. The support of the membership, and their desire to perform great music, are the reasons that the DuPage Community Concert Band continues today.

It is our goal that you enjoy the music we will be presenting in our concert. We hope you will like what you hear as much as we delight in performing it for you.



**Mark A. Taylor** (Music Director) is honored to serve as the Music Director of the College of DuPage Community Concert Band. A conductor, educator, and performer in demand throughout the Great Lakes region, Dr. Taylor has taught with distinction at every level of study, ranging from elementary, middle, and high school to collegiate, amateur, and professional

musicians. He is Music Director of Chicago Brass Band and Milwaukee Festival Brass, both award winning British-style brass bands, and Music Director of the Waukegan Band, one of America's oldest and most historic civic ensembles.

He received the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in 2016 from the University of North Texas, where his principal conducting teachers were Eugene Migliaro Corporon, Dennis Fisher, and Nicholas Enrico Williams. Dr. Taylor's dissertation, "British-Style Brass Bands in U.S. Colleges and Universities," documented the existence of brass bands in American college music programs, past and present.

Prior to his doctoral study, he served five years as Director of Bands and Coordinator of Ensembles at Loyola University Chicago. During the same period, he taught on the music education faculty at the Chicago College of Performing Arts at Roosevelt University.

Dr. Taylor received the Master of Music degree from Northwestern University, where he studied conducting with John P. Paynter and Stephen G. Peterson; he received his training in music education from renowned pedagogues Bennett Reimer and Peter Webster.

He received his undergraduate degrees from the University of Notre Dame, where his first conducting teachers were Walter Ginter and Carl Stam. His final appearance as Drum Major of the Band of the Fighting Irish coincided with the football team's most recent national championship (1989). He also performed in the Concert Band, Orchestra, Liturgical Choir, Men's Glee Club, and Collegium Musicum.

Dr. Taylor and his wife and son reside in Lake Forest, IL.



**Timothy Loest** is a name in music synonymous with creativity, versatility, and accessibility. His works for young band are performed worldwide and his pedagogical methods and conducting appearances impact performers and audiences at the state and national levels. In 2017, his composition *Cloud Gate (Reflections of a City)*

was performed for over 5,000 spectators at Chicago's Millennium

Park. That same year, Loest received the Illinois Grade School Music Association's highest honor – the Cloyd Myers Memorial Award for Excellence in Music Education.

Loest had his first work published in 1995 and has written for Warner Bros. Publications, C.L. Barnhouse Company, The FJH Music Company, MakeMusic Publications, RWS Music Company, and Belwin. In 2022, he founded Fanfare Music Press, a company dedicated to the highest quality compositions and arrangements for young band. Loest is also an experienced proofreader and editor.

With over three decades in the classroom, Loest is no stranger to instrumental pedagogy; his longstanding affiliation with The FJH Music Company has resulted in several best-selling methods (1.2 million copies sold), including *Measures of Success®: A Comprehensive Musicianship Band Method*, *Warm-ups and Beyond*, *Rhythms and Beyond*, and *Chorales and Beyond*. Outside the classroom, Loest's music has appeared on numerous network TV shows, including *The Tonight Show Starring Jimmy Fallon*, *Good Morning America*, *Extra*, and *Nick Jr.*

Loest received his Bachelor of Music Education degree with high honors from Illinois State University and his Master of Music degree with program honors from Northwestern University. He holds membership in ASCAP, the Illinois Grade School Music Association, and Christian Educators. He served his entire teaching career at F.E. Peacock Middle School in Itasca, IL, and resides in Wheaton, IL with his wife Cindy and two sons.
