PROFILES

Enjoying a national reputation as an accompanist, chamber musician, adjudicator and clinician, **William Buhr's** work as a collaborative pianist has taken him to performing engagements in more than 30 countries on six continents. Holding degrees from the University of Illinois and DePaul University, Buhr has appeared in many international festivals as well as numerous national and regional conventions of major musical and educational organizations. He joined the staff of College of DuPage in 1986 and has enjoyed an association with Anima—Young Singers of Greater Chicago (formerly the Glen Ellyn Children's Chorus) since 1984.

Dr. Mark Liu has taught music in Indian Prairie School District since 2002 and has been honored as a Most Influential Educator. He has received Outstanding Educator Awards from Boston College, Illinois Institute of Technology, Western Illinois University, and MIT, as well as the Music Inspiration Award (CYSO, 2018) and Northwestern's Distinguished Secondary Teacher Award (2018). He holds Music and Education degrees from Wheaton College, Northwestern University, Aurora University, and Boston University. Dr. Liu has directed orchestras at Metea Valley, Waubonsie Valley, Maine East High School, and the Chicago Merit School of Music. He served as the Music Director and Senior Orchestra Conductor of the Youth Symphony of DuPage from 2016 to 2024, and ILMEA Orchestra Division President from 2019-2025.

Patrick O'Shea holds the degree of Doctor of Musical Arts in Choral Music from Arizona State University, Master of Music degree in Choral Music from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and Bachelor of Music degree, *summa cum laude*, in Vocal Performance from Shenandoah Conservatory in Winchester, VA. His composition teachers have included the late Russell Woollen, as well as Thomas Fredrickson and Randall Shinn. He has served frequently as a clinician and adjudicator, and has been commissioned to write new works, particularly for choral and chamber music ensembles. Dr. O'Shea is a member of the American Choral Directors Association, the American Society of Composers Authors and Publishers, American Composers Forum, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia music fraternity.

Matt Shevitz is an in-demand musician in the jazz, blues, and popular music scenes of Chicago area. He has performed alongside such internationally renowned jazz musicians as Dick Hyman, Ignacio Berroa, Howard Levy, Frank Capp, and Frank Wess along with blues/roots rock guitarist Eric Lindell and Ropeadope Records artists Spare Parts. Shevitz has performed at Jazz in the Park Festival (Milwaukee), Waterfront


Blues Festival (Portland), Chicago Blues Festival, Lollapalooza and House of Blues in Chicago. Shevitz is a contributor to *DownBeat Magazine* since 2009 with articles analyzing transcriptions of great jazz solos as well as jazz theory and effective practice habits. Shevitz is a professor and the Director of Jazz Ensembles at the College of DuPage in Glen Ellyn, IL. He received a Doctor of Musical Arts in Jazz Performance degree from the Univ. of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, Master of Music in Jazz Pedagogy from Northwestern Univ. and a Bachelor of Science in Music from the Univ. of Oregon.

Ben Wahlund is a Grammy-nominated music educator, composer, and performer who serves as full-time percussion instructor at Northern Illinois University and the Director of Percussion at the College of DuPage where he was awarded the 2019 College-Wide Outstanding Faculty Award. Mr. Wahlund has worked for years with the Chicago Youth Symphony Orchestra, directed a number of high school regional camps and workshops, and served university residencies across the country. His music compositions have won numerous international awards and are performed by professionals around the world. Mr. Wahlund is a member of the Yamaha Performing Artist roster, the Zildjian Artist Program, and endorses Innovative Percussion Sticks and Mallets. www.benwahlund.net
