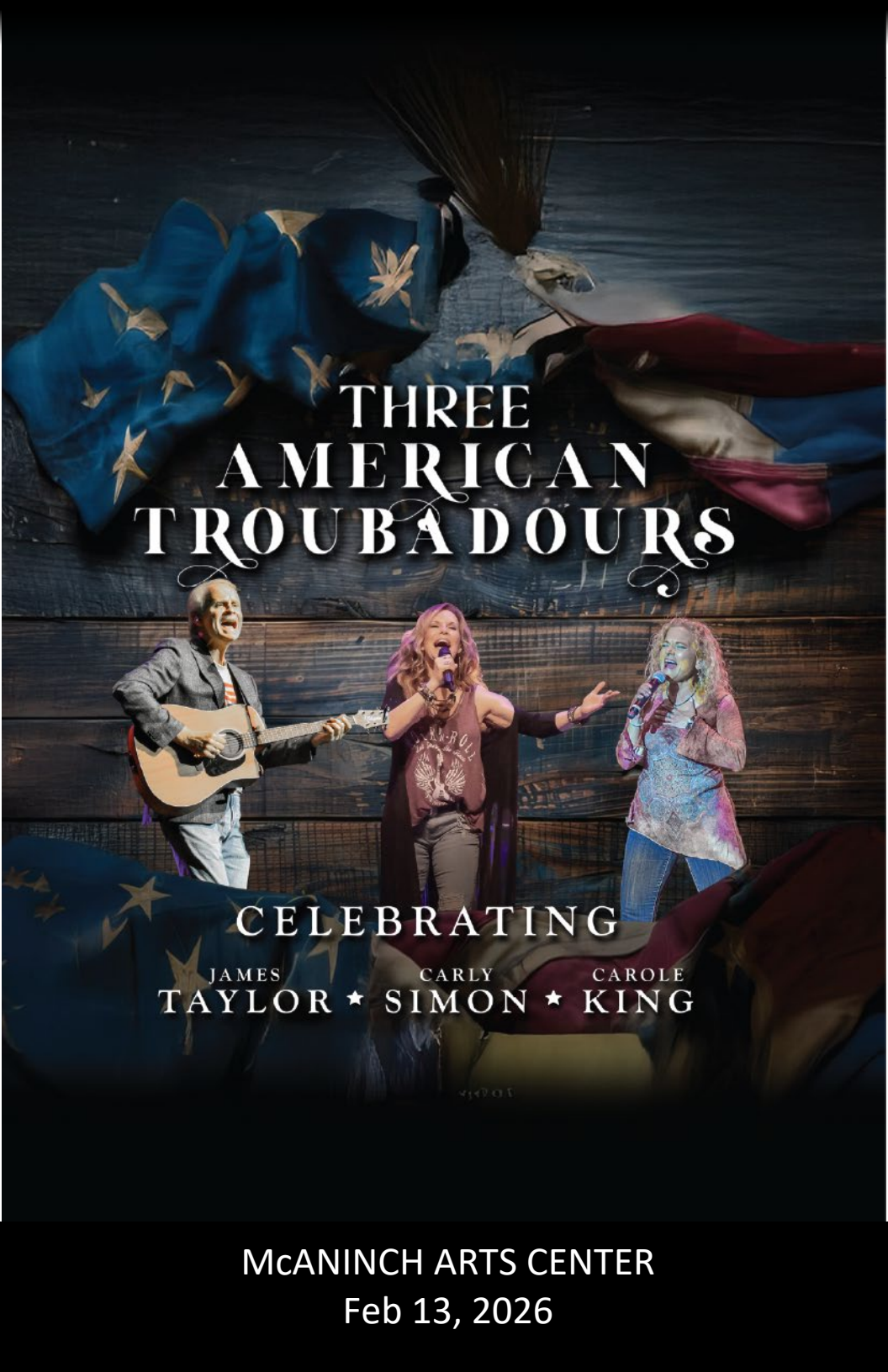

ABOUT THE SHOW

“How Sweet It Is”, “Country Road”, “Shower The People”, “Anticipation”, “You’re So Vain”, “Mockingbird”, “I Feel the Earth Move”, “It’s Too Late”, and “You’ve Got A Friend”. These are just a few of the fantastic songs you’ll hear when you see “Three American Troubadours” in concert. This memorable production celebrates the lives and careers of six-time Grammy winner James Taylor, Rock & Roll Hall of Famer Carly Simon with 13 top 40 hits, and Carole King who wrote or co-wrote 118 Billboard Hot 100 pop hits - three iconic American singer/songwriters whose personal lives and careers have intertwined throughout the years, and whose memorable hit songs continue to offer ageless inspiration. Audiences will fall in love with the show’s three powerhouse vocalists as they artfully deliver the classic hits, with unique arrangements of fan favorites, engaging storytelling, and multimedia projections to enhance the entire concert experience.

Produced by Oscar and Golden Globe winner Franke Previte, co-writer of “(I’ve Had) The Time of My Life” and “Hungry Eyes” from the movie “Dirty Dancing” and managed by Lee Shapiro, former music director of Frankie Valli and The Four Seasons, “Three American Troubadours” features: Lisa Sherman, a Broadway veteran who has shared the stage with Broadway Royalty; renowned vocalist and actress Alice Leon; and the gifted singer and guitarist James Gedeon, whose interpretation of James Taylor is genuinely remarkable. The band members have performed with such notable acts as The E Street Band, Loggins & Messina, Bon Jovi, South Side Johnny, America, Billy Joel, and many more.



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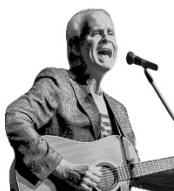


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James Gedeon began performing in New York's Greenwich Village in the late 1980s in storied venues including The Bitter End and Village Gate. He has opened for musical acts that include America, The Marshall Tucker Band, Livingstone Taylor, Kenny Loggins, Vanessa Williams, and comedians Jerry Seinfeld, Dana Carvey, and Jay Leno. He has shared the stage with Billy Joel, Harry Connick, Jr., and Phoebe Snow. A gifted songwriter, Gedeon has released three albums.



Alice Leon has a very melodic, tuneful approach to pop/rock and adult contemporary. Her direct influences have ranged from Carly Simon, Carole King, and the Beatles to Sheryl Crow. In addition to being a supreme vocalist, Leon plays guitar and keyboards. She attracted attention when she made a guest appearance on the soap, *The Guiding Light*, playing a wedding singer and performing *The Guiding Light's* theme song.



Lisa Sherman spent 11 years on and off Broadway as a singer, actress, and dancer, and shared the stage with the Radio City Rockettes for four years. She has performed and headlined at the Apollo Theatre, The Algonquin, The Vogel, and Hamilton Theatres and soloed with the Asheville Symphony Orchestra in a tribute to Paul McCartney. She has presented tribute shows including Songbird, The Best of Bonnie Raitt, Broadway and Beyond, and Decades of Divas. For Three American Troubadours, she is working with her husband, Academy Award winner and Golden Globe nominee Franke Previte, co-writer of the song "(I've Had) The Time of My Life" from Dirty Dancing.
