

Sudden Death

“Sudden” means “unexpected”, and it is unexpected because these deaths are occurring in the young and healthy.

In the VAERS database there are only 6 symptoms, out of 16849, that include the word “sudden” – these are

- “sudden death”
- “sudden cardiac death”
- “sudden hearing loss”
- “sudden visual loss”
- “sudden infant death syndrome”
- “sudden onset of sleep”

We can look at Safety Signal to see which vaccines, if any, are associated with an excessive incidence of these symptoms.

Here are lower confidence limits for the PRR for each vaccine. You can see that ONLY the COVID jab generates a safety signal for this symptom. For example, with the COVID jab the lower confidence limit is 2.65, which means that there is a 97.5% chance that the incidence will be GREATER THAN 2.6 times compared to other vaccines.

Here are lower confidence limits for the PRR for each vaccine. You can see that ONLY the COVID 19 jab generates safety signal for this symptom.

A death is only “sudden”, or “unexpected” when it occurs in an erstwhile healthy person – that’s why it takes everyone by surprise.
