

Peel Region **Free Dental Screening at School**

- Peel Public Health provides dental screening as required by the Ontario Ministry of Health.
- A dental screening is a quick assessment by a registered dental hygienist who will take a look inside the child's mouth.
- A separate, sterilized mouth mirror is used for each child.
- If a child is identified with a dental condition requiring immediate dental treatment, the parent may be contacted by a dental staff member. A re-screening may be required.

Grades: JK, SK, 2, 4, 7

Note: Dental screening may be completed earlier than the expected end date.
