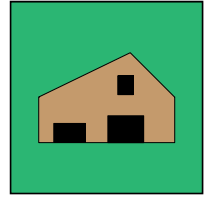




# BARN

12" block for Quilt Block Mania  
August 2025

## BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

- ¼" seam allowance used throughout
- RST = Right Sides Together
- Pressing open is the preferred method of pressing.

## MATERIALS & CUTTING:

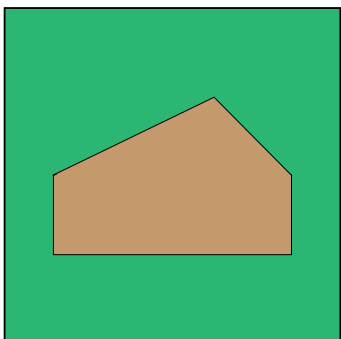
Green: 13" x 13" each  
Brown: 9" x 6"  
Black: 3" x 3"  
Heat-n-Bond: 9" x 9"

## PREPARING THE PIECES:

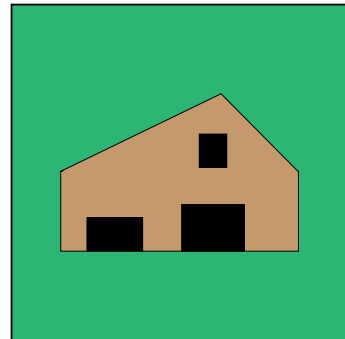
1. Adhere the Heat-n-Bond to the wrong side of the brown and black pieces.
2. Trace the shapes on the paper side of Heat-n-Bond. Cut out pieces.

## MAKING THE BARN:

1. Remove paper from the wrong side of the brown piece.
2. Center the barn on the green square.
3. Press the barn to the green square.
4. Applique barn to the green background. (My favorite is the small buttonhole stitch).



5. Remove paper from the wrong side of the black pieces.
6. Position the black pieces on the barn.
7. Press the black pieces to the barn.
8. Applique black pieces to the barn.
9. Trim to 12½" x 12½".



## FINISHING THE BLOCK:

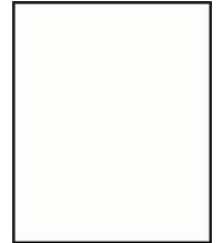
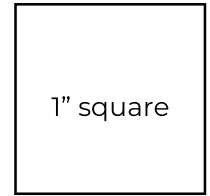
At this point, the barn can be finished. Free motion quilting could make the barn pop. Using a variety of colors (black, brown, gray), stitch vertical lines for the boards.

# BARN TEMPLATE:

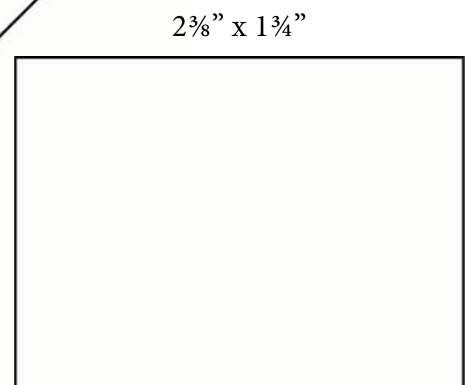
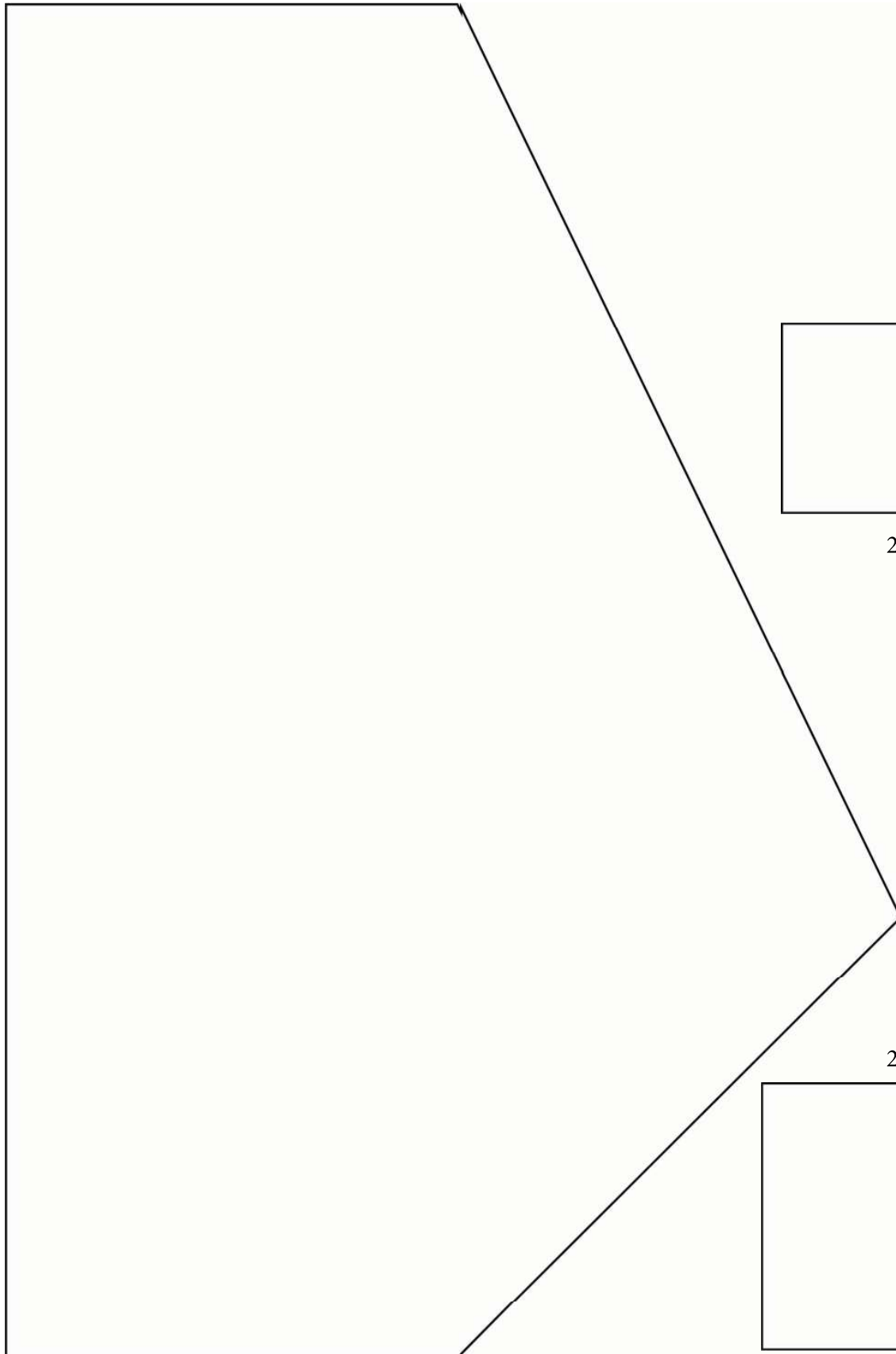
Template is 100% to scale. Printer setting should be "Actual Size, NOT "Scaled to Fit". Do not add  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Print page to ensure printer is aligned correctly. The square should measure 1".

2 $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ "



2 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
