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1. PAKISTAN SOFTWARE EXPORT BOARD (G) LTD. AN INTRODUCTION

The Pakistan Software Export Board (PSEB) is the entity within the Government charged with the task of accelerating growth in the Information Technology (IT) and Information Technology enabled services (ITeS) industry. PSEB is a guaranteed limited company owned and funded by the Government of Pakistan. It is under the administrative control of the Federal Ministry of Information Technology and Telecommunications. It is governed by a Board of Directors chaired by the Federal Minister of IT and Telecommunications. Through its many support programs, PSEB aims to help Pakistani IT companies and IT professionals in obtaining a greater share of the global IT and ITeS marketplace.

2. INTRODUCTION TO THE PROJECT

PSEB intends to hire a web hosting and Support & Maintenance services for the DFDI Web Portal.

Keeping in view the roles and objectives for promoting IT in Pakistan and attracting foreign investment in this sector, PSEB has developed a DFDI web portal with much enhanced functionalities with a concept to provide DFDI members a platform for coordination and information sharing.

3. PURPOSE OF THE DOCUMENT

This document serves for outlining the methodology and criteria to be adopted by PSEB in the assessment, evaluation, and selection of a firm or company for web hosting and maintenance services for DFDI portal. This document also illustrates the requirements and the conditions, which shall be adhered to fulfill and qualify for the stipulated task of DFDI portal hosting.

The selected company will be required to provide **Managed Hosting and Maintenance Services** for a period of one, two or three years as agreed by PSEB and contingent on better pricing with subsequent extension, subject to satisfactory performance.

4. HOSTING REQUIREMENTS

Following are the hosting requirements for the DFDI Portal.

4.1 General Requirements

- a. Managed hosting services and support and maintenance services are required.
- b. Mirrored Server, Back-up & Disaster Recovery at a different site, DNS Hosting.
- c. Backup-as-a-Service with 1 Full Backup and 7 Incremental Backups
- d. Manual Snapshots for Point-in-Time Data Recovery with retention of 3 copies
- e. Managed local cloud-based hosting and/or datacenter based hosting and associated services like NFS, Database etc.. The hosting provider will be responsible for platform configuration, schedule backups, disaster recovery and optimization of the configuration from time to time as per required by the application to run smoothly and to ensure the high availability of the database.
- f. Cloudflare Load balancer with Active Passive Failover
- g. Managed Security Services: Shared Next Generation Firewall and VPN Connectivity
- h. Web-based portal performance monitoring tools

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- i. Web-based service management tools like cPanel or Plesk Panel.
- j. Access to VM monitoring dashboard with alerts feature on portal.
- k. Tier-I bandwidth connectivity as per portal requirements.
- l. SLA with 99.9% uptime and infrastructure guarantee.
- m. CDN Integration on server level or a third-party service like., Cloudflare. This will be the hosting service provider's responsibility to arrange required licensing, if required.
- n. SSH and SFTP Access to root user to all machines.
- o. SSL Certificates for the portal.
- p. SMTP service to deliver emails to internal and external customers of the portal.
- q. Multiple domains hosting (optional)
- r. 24/7 Technical Support of the hosting infrastructure.

Email Service incl. SMTP management, API Interfaces and IP Pooling (to avoid spamming) with detailed tabular and graphical reporting i.e., Delivery Status, Unsubscribes etc. (If a paid solution is quoted then the price must be mentioned separately)

4.2 Maintenance & Support Re-equipment's:

- a. Comprehensive application-level support including corrective, preventive, adaptive, and perfective maintenance
- b. Timely resolution of bugs, technical errors, and performance issues in the live environment
- c. Regular health checks, security assessments, and application patch updates
- d. Adjustments to maintain compatibility with evolving third-party services, platforms, or browser versions
- e. Minor enhancements and user interface improvements based on operational feedback
- f. 24/7 technical support through a helpdesk or ticketing system with issue prioritization and escalation
- g. Monthly reporting on issues logged, resolved, and pending with relevant performance metrics
- h. Maintenance of up-to-date technical documentation and user manuals
- i. Knowledge transfer sessions for the client's internal technical team (if required)
- j. Incident resolution timelines defined under a formal Service Level Agreement (SLA)
- k. Controlled deployment process for all approved changes, including testing in a staging environment
- l. Availability of a dedicated maintenance team or resource pool including developers and support engineers

Note: Any major modifications, such as addition of new modules or significant feature development, shall not be covered under routine maintenance and will require a formal change request along with reasonable cost estimation and approval.

4.3 Security Requirements

- a. Virus and Malware Protection
- b. IPS (DoS/DDoS Mitigation) – Network + Server level
- c. Spyware Control
- d. Web Server Security Protocols
- e. Database Protection
- f. Server-Side Scripting Protection
- g. Firewall Protection
- h. Ransomware protection

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- i. To keep the OS and other platform applications updated with security patches as per the requirements of the Application vendor.
- j. User Activity Monitoring and Logging

4.4 Hardware Requirements

Two tiers of virtual machine (VM) specifications will be required for hosting the DFDI Portal. A medium-spec VM will be provisioned for 8–10 months annually to support routine operations, while a high-spec VM will be required for a period of 1 to 4 months during the actual DFDI event. The same VM instance must be upgradable to the higher specification as needed, and this upgrade duration will be communicated by PSEB in line with the annual DFDI event schedule.

The vendor is required to quote the pricing for the below-mentioned hardware specifications. Additionally, unit rates for key resources—vCPUs, RAM, and storage—must also be quoted separately to allow scalability on demand during the event. These rates should apply to both medium and high-spec configurations. It is further emphasized that there shall be no compromise on the security features and controls of the hosting platform under either specification.

The costing sheet shall only be the part of financial proposal and shall not be disclosed in technical proposal in any way Failure to comply with this instruction will result in the disqualification of the bid.

4.5 Software Requirements

The following outlines the minimum software requirements to support portal hosting. it is the responsibility of the bidder/hosting service provider to install the required software on respective VMs and ensure their readiness for use.

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The evaluation process will adhere to the following criteria

1. The weightage of Technical Proposal =70%.
2. The weightage of Financial Proposal = 30%

5.3 Financial Bid Evaluation Criteria

The financial bids of only technically qualified bidders will be opened. The pricing shall include all applicable taxes.

The evaluation of financial bids will be calculated as follows:

- The weightage of financial proposal is 30% in total score.
- The financial weightage will be calculated by the formula as given below:

$$= (\text{lowest bid}/\text{bid offered}) * 30$$

The score achieved by a bidder will be aggregated as follows:

Total score obtained by a bidder = Technical weightage + Financial weightage

The contract shall be awarded to the bidder who achieved the maximum points from Total Score and shall be considered a **Most Advantageous Bidder**.

Following terms shall be taken care while drafting financial proposal:

- Cost of hosting service for 1, 2 and 3 years taking into account the discounts for long-term service agreement.
- Payment will be postpaid on quarterly basis.
- Detailed breakdown of all the costs.
- Financial Proposal should include all taxes cost (cost mentioned in proposal will be considered final cost inclusive of all taxes)

6. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRACTICES BY BIDDER.

Any instance of corrupt or fraudulent practices or provision of any false information by the bidder will result in disqualification of the bid and confiscation of the bid security regardless of the price and quality of the product.

7. SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

a. Single Stage Two Envelope Bidding Process

A single stage two envelope bidding process will be followed. The technical and financial bids shall be in English language “Tender for Web Hosting of DFDI Portal” The technical bid

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has to apply with “**Technical Proposal for Web Hosting of DFDI Portal**” containing technical specifications only (without prices). The financial proposal shall be marked with “**Financial Proposal for Web Hosting of DFDI Portal**” containing financial proposal,

The earnest money in the shape of Demand Draft and Pay Order in the favor of Pakistan Software Export Board with an amounting to Rs. **300,000/-**.

b. Bid Submission and Opening

Bids should be submitted electronically ONLY through EPADS. For registration and training on EPADS or in case of any technical difficulty in using EPADS, prospective bidders may contact PPRA Team, Director MIS Room No.109, 1st Floor, FBC building Sector G-5/2, Islamabad. Contact Number 051-111-137-237.

The bids, prepared in accordance with the instructions in the bidding documents along with bid security instrument (Copy) & Proof of Eligibility documents as specified in bid documents in favor of the undersigned must be submitted through EPADS by **09th September, 2025 at 03:00 pm** **Technical bids only will be opened on the same day at 03:30 pm** at below mentioned address in the presence of vendors/bidders or their authorized representatives who desires to attend the bid opening session. The financial bids will be opened only of those bidders who qualifies in technical proposals evaluation. The opening of financial bids will be notified separately once technical evaluation has been completed. Please note that submission date and time shall be strictly adhered, and it will be bidders’ responsibility to ensure the submission of bid at given date and time.

Note: Original Bid Security instrument MUST BE submitted to the undersigned before closing hours of the bids submission time.

Only those bids will be entertained who applied through EPADS <https://eprocure.gov.pk>

c. Prices

Prices quoted must remain valid for acceptance up to 90 days from the date of its opening. Quoted price should be in Pak Rupees and inclusive of all applicable taxes. Prices quoted without any tax remarks will be treated as inclusive of all applicable taxes. Any changes in Government duties or taxes shall be borne by the successful bidder.

d. Performance Bond

The bidder selected to award the contract shall have to submit 10% of total amount as Performance Bond. The performance bond must be submitted in the form of a Bank Guarantee, Bank Draft, or Pay Order in favor of "Pakistan Software Export Board." It will be the vendor’s responsibility to ensure that the submitted instrument remains valid not only for the entire duration of the initial contract period but also for any extended period, in case the contract is renewed or extended. The vendor must arrange for timely renewal or extension of the instrument to avoid any lapse in coverage.

e. Representation Requirements

The representative of the bidder shall bring an authority/nomination letter on company’s letterhead for attending the financial bid opening. The representative of the bidder shall bring an authority/nomination letter on company’s letterhead for attending the financial bid opening.

8.1 Withdrawal of Bid.

- a. A bidder may withdraw the bid prior to the deadline for submission of bid as prescribed in these tender documents.
- b. The bid security will be forfeited if a bidder withdraws the bid after the deadline of bid

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submission or during the period of bid validity or in the case of a successful bidder fails to sign/accept the Purchase Order/Contract.

8.2 Rejection of Bid.

- a. Bid security has not been submitted as per the relevant clause.
- b. Incomplete, conditional, or optional bids will be rejected forthwith.
- c. Bids received after due date & time will not be accepted.
- d. Bids failing to meet the eligibility / evaluation criteria.
- e. Any noncompliance to the terms and conditions of bidding documents.
- f. Company shall be disqualified if financial figures are mentioned in the technical proposal.

8.3 Compliance to the Instructions.

- a. Quoted rates shall include all applicable GoP taxes otherwise all the prices quoted will be considered all taxes included.
- b. No cutting / overwriting of the offered prices will be accepted.
- c. Strict Compliance of bidding documents, given Specifications and eligibility / qualification criteria.

8.4 Performance of Bidder.

- a. In case of any poor performance by the selected bidder, PSEB reserves the right to issue Poor Performance Certificate to bidder. PSEB reserves the right to confiscate the bid security/performance bond of the bidder in case of three poor performance certificate, and bar the bidder from participation in future procurements of PSEB.

9. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

- a. Should the selected bidders decline to accept the Purchase Order/Contract, their bid security will be confiscated, and a poor performance certificate will be issued to vendor.
- b. In the event of a discrepancy between the unit price and total price for any items quoted in the bid, the unit price of that/those items shall prevail and decision of PSEB in this regard shall be final.
- c. Total Prices must align with the individual prices of all the items quoted and delivered.
- d. Participating vendors are requested to abstain from all overt & covert activities that may arise any doubt or ambiguity in the tendering process and tender opening session.
- e. Joint Venture (JV) is allowed between a development company and hosting company to provide uninterrupted hosting and high-quality maintenance services. However PSEB team will only be in coordination with company applying in this tender for hosting and maintenance services of DFDI portal.

10. BIDDER'S QUERIES.

Any queries by the Bidders must be addressed at least three (3) working days before the bid submission deadline, otherwise PSEB will not be liable to respond.

11. PRE-BID MEETING.
